BROWNE, REILLY Looking for St Mary's Catholic Church marriage document for my great grandparents Charles J Browne and Margaret Reilly married in Newry Co Down July 21, 1882 shown on the civil record. He was born in Germany and converted to Catholicism same day as the marriage. They did move to Glasgow as I find them in the census 1891 and 1901. Member A3171

MOORCROFT, MILLS, M^cCULLOUGH, MOFFAT I am seeking information regarding family descendants of Robert Moorcroft who married Jane Mills 1824 in Co Armagh. They had at least two children, a son Andrew born 1825 who married Jane M^cCulloch in 1845 and another son Robert who married Margaret Moffat about 1859. Both these sons moved to Lanarkshire, Scotland with their wives in the mid to late 1800s. Robert & Margaret had a son David born 28 March 1864 Darkley, Keady, Co Armagh before they moved to Scotland. SHAW, M^cMORRAN, PRINGLE I would like to find the baptisms of Emily Elizabeth Shaw c.1818 Belfast daughter of Samuel Shaw master mariner and Isabella and Isabella M^cMorran c.1797 possibly in Downpatrick or Scotland daughter of William M^cMorran and Eliza Pringle. A sister of Emily was baptized St Anne's Belfast January 1828. Member A3240

FEARON My great grandfather Felix b 1848 in Liverpool, his parents were Patrick and Ellen Fearon both born in Ireland no area given. In 1851 census Felix and his brother also Patrick were living with their uncle James Fearon aged 30 and his wife Bridget 28 in Liverpool. No sign of Patrick and Ellen. James & Bridget born Ireland. CARSON, BOYD Seeking information about ancestors William Carson b. 1798 was a wine merchant and his wife was from Newry. Capt Boyd founded Blackstaff Mill. He may have been a midshipman at Trafalgar. I have more information which may help in the research. I have lodged charts in the Society Library. Member A3250

GRAY, LYNIS, CHAPMAN, TODD Information concerning family John Gray and Jane Lynis married Magheralin 1835. Lived Old Warren until 1881 son Thomas born Moira 1837. Migrated Australia 1863 son William lived Lurganure, married Sarah Swan, Lisburn 1864. Elizabeth Chapman 1875 Martha Todd 1880 daughter Henrietta married John Gawn Todd Lisburn 1881, lived Downpatrick until 1894 Member A3259

MULHOLLAND Looking for Thomas Mulholland before marriage in Newtownards in 1849 to Agnes Smylie Member A3261

WELSH, WALSH This family lived in Newtownards, Scrabo, Comber & Ballymacarrett. Gf Stewart m. Maryann Parker 29.12.1863 St Marks Church. He was a freestone quarryman. His father Wm John was a labourer (m) Eliza Morgan b. 1800'a d. 1813? Greengraves. She was by then a widow. All births, marriage were held at the 1st Presbyterian. I have no idea of their origins or how they connect to each other. A Tom Welsh of Scrabo is named on another certificate I have (b) 31.5.1823 Downpatrick. Stewart and family emigrated to Annan, Dumfries in 1880. I have documented them from there. Member A3273

M^cCRACKEN, M^cGIMPSEY William M^cCracken b. 1829 Dunover, Ballywalter, Co Down. Parents John M^cCracken and Hannah M^cGimpsey. William married 1851, son Wm b. 1854 Newtownards, Mary E 1861 Pennsylvania, Alice 1864 Ohio, Bertha 1870 Pennsylvania, James 1871 Ohio. Grateful for any information on this family. Member B0412
