**SCOTT** Thomas Scott 1814-1898 farmer and mill owner of Mt Norris, Co Armagh married Agnes c. 1840. Issue: John 1841-1929, James 1843-1918, Agnes M 1846-1915, Thomas 1848-1940, Jane E 1850-1890, Susan 1855-1934, Sarah 1857- 1946. Looking for connections and Agnes's maiden name. Member A0103

**M<sup>o</sup>NEILL, MOONEY** Seek to establish that Patrick M<sup>o</sup>Neill b. March 1820 and wife Margaret Mooney b. 1819 lived in or near Cushendall, Co Antrim. Did they own land? They emigrated to USA in 1847. Would appreciate any information. Member A2500

**M<sup>o</sup>CUTCHEON, COBB** Joseph M<sup>o</sup>Cutcheon born about 1800 Ireland married Mary Frances Cobb born about 1815, 11 July 1835 Quebec City Trinity Anglican Cathedral, tailor by occupation. Lived, died and buried in Toronto. Children Edward, William, Robert, James and Catherine Elizabeth. His wife's parents were Elizabeth and Thomas Cobb possibly military. Member A2693

**WELSH, CHAPMAN, McGINNIS, ROBB** Brothers Stewart, Isaac b. c. 1808, Robert b. Nov 1810, living in Monaghan 1800-1840, Stewart married Elizabeth Chapman d/o John. Son Robert b. Feb 1835 Drum C.I., Currin P., Monaghan. Brother Robert married Nancy M<sup>o</sup>Ginnis b. 1803, Beragh, Omagh P., Tyrone d/o unknown M<sup>o</sup>Ginnis and unknown Robb. Member A3139

**MAYES, MAIZE, MAYS** Mayes etc, Arthur born c.1839 ( son of George); Morgan, Mary, born c.1840 daughter of James); children John c.1864, Elleanor 1865, Arthur 1867, Emma 1869, George 1871, George 1873, Margaret 1875, Edward 1897, William c.1884, perhaps Sarah (adopted) Member A3300

**BITTLE** Bittle, Robert (son of Joseph); Nelson (Neilson) Agnes (daughter of James); married 13 July 1855, Limavady. Children: Anna Platt 1861, Mary 1865, David 1867, Agnes 1869, Jane 1871. Resided for some time in Newtownards. Member A3300

**BRODIE, BRODDY, TODD** Brothers James, Robert (a cooper), William (a smith), and Alexander Brodie or Broddy and their sister, Elizabeth Macauley, emigrated to Ontario, Canada about 1819 from Co Tyrone perhaps Strabane. Also William and Jane Todd and their children, John, William (a surgeon), Oliver and Eleanor, 1819 to 1824 from Co Tyrone. Member A3305

**GRAHAM, LINN** Jeremiah born 1796 wife unknown lived in Glenavy. Children Robert 1829, Alexander 1834, George 1840, James 1842, Joseph 1844. Robert married Mary Ann Linn again from Glenavy at Lisburn Register Office 1854. Children Isaac 1863, George 1864, Mary Anne Clementina 1867 and Samuel Robert 1870 Member A3330

**M<sup>c</sup>CLELLAND, M<sup>c</sup>CONNELL, FINLAY** Seeking details of the family of John M<sup>c</sup>Clelland and Jane M<sup>c</sup>Connell married 13 May 1833 in Bangor. Parents' names not listed. Two sons gave them as parents on marriage registers. Listed as parents on death certificate of Sarah Finlay. Two daughters' details from church Donaghadee. Are there other children? Member A3404

**M<sup>c</sup>GUIRE, MULLEN** Andrew M<sup>c</sup>Guire born 1809 and Rose Mullen? born about 1812 married about 1830 in Maguiresbridge and had at least three children there including Thomas born 18 Nov 1833, James born 1837, and Roseann/anna born 1844. Andrew's father may be Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Guire born about 1785 and Rose's father may be James Mullen. Family moved to England/USA in 1844/55. Grateful to receive any information. Member A3412

**NEILL, MUSSEN** James Neill, father James, married Margaret Mussen, father James, farmer 1857 St Paul's Church Belfast. He was a station master in Banbridge. He died in 1881. They had 13 children. Daughter Mary Beckett had sons, Edmund James born in America. Neill family church was Seapatrik. Any information would be appreciated. Member A3452

**M<sup>c</sup>KEE, HILL** Trying to locate birth details for Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Kee born c. 1850 in the Conlig/Ballygrainey area of Co Down. I have a marriage record of Thomas marrying Martha Hill 22.5.1877 which gives one of the witnesses as Martha M<sup>c</sup>Kee. Perhaps Thomas's mother or sister. Any information appreciated. **AICKEN, RUSSELL** Seeking information of Aicken family in Co Down particularly information of James Aicken, farmer, of Bangor in 1800s and his son William Aicken born c. 1845-48 in Bangor, mother possibly Elizabeth Russell Member A3501
